Enrolement

Submit your application with preferred dates at least one month prior to the program commencement, and we will contact you to confirm. For members of the RACGP, there is an opportunity to qualify for CPD points.

Please note that the 2-day course is available on either Monday to Tuesday or Wednesday to Thursday.

What to bring

We suggest that you bring your dermatoscope along to the clinical attachment. Everything else will be provided. We provide weekday structured activities from 8:30 am to 12:00 pm and 1:00 pm to 4:30 pm Monday to Friday.





Travel and stay

Participants are expected to independently organise and fund their travel and accommodation throughout the program.

The FNQH Cairns Training Centre of Excellence is only a 10-minute drive from the Cairns
Esplanade, which overlooks the Great Barrier
Reef. Visitors can enjoy the Cairns nightlife,
walking tracks, shaded paths and many other
activities.

Course Fees

To participate in the program, medical professionals need to submit their application along with their preferred dates at least one month before the start date. When the placement is confirmed, an initial payment of 10% of the course fee is required, and the remaining amount is due 14 days before the program starts.

Please note that the 2-day course is available on either Monday to Tuesday or Wednesday to Thursday.
