The program caters to all levels of expertise, ranging from novices to experienced skincare professionals. The training centre is accessible, just 15 minutes from Cairns Airport and 10 minutes to accommodation and the iconic Cairns Esplanade, a focal point for locals and visitors.

Program Outline - Nurses

We offer Clinical Attachment Programs lasting two to four days. Our programs focus on skin cancer, dermatopathology, and patient care.

Introduction to Skin Cancer:

- Wound management.
- Pain management and symptom control.

Enrolement

Submit your application with preferred dates at least one month prior to the program commencement, and we will contact you to confirm.

Please note that the 2-day course is available on either Monday to Tuesday or Wednesday to Thursday.

What to bring

We suggest that you wear comfortable clothing or scrubs. Everything else will be provided. We provide weekday structured activities from 8:30 am to 12:00 pm and 1:00 pm to 4:30 pm, Monday to Friday.



Travel and stay

Participants are expected to independently organise and fund their travel and accommodation throughout the program.

The FNQH Cairns Training Centre of Excellence is only a 10-minute drive from the Cairns Esplanade, which overlooks the Great Barrier Reef. Visitors can enjoy the Cairns nightlife, walking tracks, shaded paths and many other activities.

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Cairns is a popular travel destination for tourists from all around the world, the region attracts more than 2 million domestic and international visitors each year.

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Course Fees

To participate in the program, applicants must submit their application and preferred dates at least one month before the start date. When the placement is confirmed, an initial payment of 10% of the course fee is required, and the remaining amount is due 14 days before the program starts.

Please note that the 2-day course is available Monday to Tuesday or Wednesday to Thursday. If you're interested in starting your skin cancer clinic, we also offer an additional course component to help you build and optimise your business.
